

A regular meeting of the Coke Co. Appraisal Review Board was held June 24, 2022 in the jury room of the Coke County Courthouse.

All members were present: Joe Harmon, Roy Blair and Phillip Ratliff.

The oath of office was administered to Joe Harmon. Due to a conflict-of-interest Inga Elliott is unable to serve on the ARB.

Changes to the 2021 and 2022 tax roll were presented by the chief appraiser. Phillip Ratliff made a motion to accept the second quarter roll changes as presented, second by Joe Harmon, all in favor.

At this time the first Protest Hearing of the 2022 appraisal district began.

Four individuals came in person to protest, there were several telephone conference protests heard as well as affidavits. A recording of the protests is located on chief appraiser's computer. All protests were heard and the ARB made rulings on each one. The chief appraiser will mail each protester heard the ARB rulings, instructions on arbitration and a survey of the ARB. All rulings will be mailed Monday, June 27, 2022 by certified mail.

The next ARB meeting will be at 9:00 a.m., Thursday, July 14, 2022. All timely filed protests will be heard and the 2022 Coke Appraisal Roll will be certified.
