

The Coke Central Appraisal District Review Board met in regular session March 29, 2022 at 8:30 a.m.

Members present were Roy Blair and Phillip Ratliff. A search is still underway for a third member. Chief Appraiser Gayle Sisemore was also present.

Roy Blair called the meeting to order.

The Oath of Office was administered to Mr. Blair and Mr. Ratliff.

Judge Dusek has not yet named office for 2022.

Changes to the 2021 appraisal roll were presented by the Chief Appraiser. The Board explained to Phillip what the report was for and what part the ARB played in roll changes. Phillip Ratliff made a motion to accept the changes as presented, second by Roy Blair.

The virtual ARB training was discussed. Phillip has taken the new member training and his certificate should be received shortly. Roy stated he has not taken his yet but will get that taken care of shortly. Phillip will also take the Open Meetings training before protests.

The first protest hearing is scheduled for June 24, 2022. The board will meet again before May 15th to receive the appraisal records.

A copy of Rules and Procedures for Protests was given to each board member. It will be reviewed by ARB and will be on the agenda for next meeting to address any issues or changes that need to be made.
